Stocks – Sector/Industry

Link – Sectors, defined & examples

•The **term industry** refers to a series of companies that operate in a similar business sphere, and its categorization is more narrow.

•**Sector** refers to a part of the economy in which a great number of companies can be categorized and is larger in comparison.

Example:

Company	Best Buy Inc	Skechers	Ford Motor Co.
Sector	Consumer Cyclical	Consumer Cyclical	Consumer Cyclical
Industry	Specialty Retail	Footwear & Access.	Auto Manufactures

When using Indexes, you eliminate having to know if the company is private or public. All of the companies (stocks) in an index are publicly traded stocks.

Just remember if a stock is trading below \$3.00 students will not be able to buy it.

Remember must buy at least 10 shares.
