*I have my students buy \$10,000.00 for each stock they choose.

$\$10,000.00 \div \text{current stock price} = \text{how many shares to buy}$

For example: Skechers is trading at 36.98. Students can round to the nearest dollar value. 36.98 rounded to the nearest 1 dollar is **\$37.00**

$10,000.00 \div 37 = \mathbf{270 \text{ shares to buy}}$
