\$10,000.00 ÷ current stock price = how many shares to buy

For example: Skechers is trading at 36.98. Students can round to the nearest

dollar value. 36.98 rounded to the nearest 1 dollar is \$37.00

 $10,000.00 \div 37 = 270$ shares to buy
