Sector	vs	Sector	Using the Sector link , students choose stocks from a specific sector.
Index	vs	Index	Using the Index links, students choose stocks from one of the indices. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The Dow 30 (Large Cap) - link • The S&P 500 (Large Cap) - link • The S&P 400 (Mid Cap) - link • The Russell 2000 (Small Cap) - link • Use the NEWDAY list from their student/team portfolio
